Beginning this year, entrants may submit an electronic image of one entry for posting on our website.

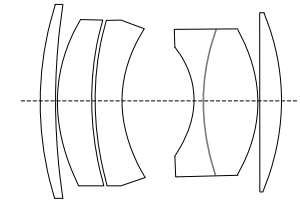
About WTPSL
